ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Sacred Heart College, Madanthyar, was founded in 1982 by Late Fr Ligoury D'Souza with the express purpose of serving the higher education needs of rural youth. The college is a minority institution and is managed by The Catholic Board of Education, Mangalore at the apex level and by a Governing Council at the local level. It is affiliated to Mangalore University. The college offers B.A., B.Com & B.C.A. Degree and Post Graduate Degree in M.Com. The college imparts a high quality of education and secures a high percentage of results and ranks in University examinations. The college is located 48Kms away from Mangalore and 100 km away from Chickmagaluru.



EMBLEM AND MOTTO

An artistic representation of Madanthyar nestling in the foothills of the Western Ghats and Kudremukh forms the base of the emblem. The open book and the lighted lamp stand for the aim of this institution to lead young people from the darkness of ignorance to the brightness of knowledge. REV. FR LIGOURY D'SOUZA

On 10 May 1972 Rev. Fr Ligoury D'Souza, as a priest, arrived to Madanthyar and took firm steps to implement a plan that could change the very shape of Madanthyar by trusting in the Sacred Heart of Jesus. He applied to the Government of Karnataka to open a high school, pre-university and a degree college through the Catholic Board of Education. As a result, on 29th June 1981, Sacred Heart High School came into existence and later, it converted into a Pre-University College. A year later in July 1982 Sacred Heart College, affiliated to Mangalore University was established.

Rev. Fr. Lawrence Rodrigues was the founder Principal of Sacred Heart College. Fr. Ligoury D' Souza constructed a three-storey building for Sacred Heart College. But before those plans materialized, he was transferred to Kulashekara Parish in Mangalore. Fr. D'Souza was the key factor in raising the academic standards through his memorable 11-year-long service. Envisioning higher education for Madanthyar has led thousands of knowledge seekers to find their careers at National & International level as well. His religious consciousness and spiritual encouragement are immense. The extraordinary service rendered by him is not only memorable but also immortalized in the pages of history and in the hearts of people. The Blessed One left this world on 2nd September 1985.

THE CREATOR OF MODERN MADANTHYAR : REV. DR FRED V. PEREIRA

Rev. Dr Fred V. Pereira took charge as the parish priest & correspondent of Sacred Heart Church & Sacred Heart Educational Institutions on 3rd June 1983. He visited people's houses and observed the situation of people. He realized that though there was an opportunity for higher education, economically weaker people did not have the benefit of it.

Fr Pereira undertook two separate programmes. In 1984, he launched a house-building scheme and also made a system of providing interest-free loans to the needy irrespective of caste & religion. For college students, he introduced the 'earn while you learn' scheme. Through the scheme, many students became financially empowered to pursue higher education.

The foundation stone laying ceremony was held for the college building on 10th June 1983 and construction work started with minimal resources. Undaunted by the great leadership, with faith in God, Rev. Father prepared the ground floor of the college for inauguration on 15th June 1984. The lower floor was built in 1984 with plans to open a Sacred Heart Hostel to accommodate distant students. Today, this 'Vidyadegula' is providing the highest level of education to thousands of students to brighten their lives.

The College has a three-tier system of management. At the apex is The Catholic Board of Education, Mangalore headed by the Bishop. At the local level, the Governing Council under the Correspondent ship of the local Parish Priest sees to the administration, supervision and welfare. Most Rev Dr Peter Paul Saldanha, The Bishop of Mangalore Diocese is the president of CBE. Catholic Board of Education is currently managing 165 Primary Schools, 66 High schools, 16 Pre-University Colleges, 11 Degree Colleges and 1 Technical institute.

NEP 2020

- National Education Policy 2020 has emphasized the use of technology in multiple ways to enhance the teaching-learning experience and also to make quality education accessible for masses.
- NEP, the students will now have options of multiple exits during their UG programme.
- Each degree program carries a certain number of Credits.
- Credits represent the weightage of a course and are a function of teaching, learning and evaluation strategies.
- 2 hours of instruction per week in a Semester carries 1 Credit.
- 1 Credit equivalent to 50 marks.
- A three-year degree programme will have a maximum of 100 Credits or 104 credits.
- The degree programmes are structured on a Semester basis
- Apart from the mandatory subjects of study students at different levels will study foundation courses, general studies and inter-disciplinary subjects along with electives.
- Participation of students in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities is Compulsory as these are a part of the Credit Based scheme.

COURSES OFFERED:

The college offers 3 UG degree programmes & 1 PG degree programme under the New Education Policy 2020 of Mangalore University. Each year comprises of two semesters with 16 weeks of teaching in each semester (Excluding the time spent on the conduct of the final examination of each semester). At the end of each semester, the university conducts examinations. Ranks & Alpha grades are announced on the basis of the performance of the students in all the six semesters put together. To entitle to the degree, one should pass all University prescribed examinations.

BACHELOR OF ARTS (B.A.)

The Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree is an undergraduate post secondary degree that puts a focus on liberal arts and studies. The Bachelor of Arts degree has been prominent in academics for centuries. It strives to give students a wide understanding of the humanities and social sciences through the several B.A. concentrations available.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- Application for admission must be made in the prescribed form available with this booklet.
- Provisional marks of the qualifying examinations can be entered in the application form
- Students belonging to SC/ST category should attach the appropriate certificate issued by the competent authority
- Applicants will be intimated over the phone about their provisional selection and schedule for an interview within 10 days from the last date for registration.

During the interview, the applicant should produce the following Certificates/ Documents.

- 1. Transfer Certificate (TC) from the institution last attended and Marks card of the qualifying examination
- 2. Conduct Certificate
- 3. Color Xerox Copy of The SSLC Marks Card
- 4. Three recent Passport Size color photos.
- 5. Photocopy of the Income and Caste Certificate, Aadhar Card of the student.
- 6. Document for proof of reservation/ concession claimed
- 7. Migration/eligibility certificate issued by Mangalore University if the candidate is from the other state

The selected candidates will be enrolled forthwith, on payment of the prescribed fee.

- All admissions are subject to approval from the Mangalore University.
- Filling out the application does not guarantee a seat in the institutions
- Students must provide mobile numbers of themselves and the parents.

DRESS CODE:


All the students are required to abide by the dress code of the College whenever they are on campus-working days, examinations, Fests, annual celebrations, special classes and EC/CC activities.

FOR MEN (FORMAL WEAR)

- The dress material should be the College Uniform with the ribbed stitching pattern.
- Shirts should be in formal style (half sleeves only) without any designs or trendy cuts.
- "Trousers should be in formal style: full length straight cut and not in baggy, cargo, low-waist, pencil /carrot cut or in any other style.

FOR WOMEN (SALWAR KAMEEZ)

- The dress material should be the College Uniform with the prescribed stitching pattern.
- Tops should be round in 'Nehru collar' style. Deep neck and long slit patterns are banned.
- Pants should be formal. Push-ups and leggings are banned.
- Stoles, Shorts kurtas, the coloring of hair, piercing the body for studding, etc. are not allowed.
- Uniforms should be prominently displayed. Scarves/head coverings are strictly prohibited.



IMPORTANT GUIDLINES

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:

The medium of instruction and examination is English. However, the university permits the students to write the semester exams in Kannada in selected subject disciplines.

DISCIPLINE

Causing disturbance within the college premises, library, reading room, common room, and playground, insubordination and disrespect to the teacher within or outside the college premises, loitering on the corridors making noise and disturbing the classes, picking up quarrels with the staff - teaching or nonteaching - or with other students and any other act or acts which the Principal may deem as acts of indiscipline.

ATTENDANCE:

Students are required to attend all the classes. In a matter of necessity, it is essential to take permission of the Principal before leaving the campus. To attend the semester examinations the student is required to have not less than 75% of attendance in each subject held during the semester.

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT TEST

Two Internal Assessment tests will be conducted during a semester as per the University guidelines. The Internal Assessment marks will be based on two tests or one test and one assignment. The test will be of at least 1-hour duration. The average of the two shall be taken as the internal assessment marks.

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS

A candidate should register for all the papers in the subject of a semester when he/she appears for the examination of that semester

for the first time. No candidate would be declared to have passed the First Semester Examination or as the case may be under Group I/Group II/ Group III unless he/she obtains not less than 35% marks in written examination and 35% marks in the aggregate of written examination and internal assessment put together in each of the subjects.

STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

RAGGING

- Any act which results in physical or psychological harm like teasing, abusing or asking any student to do any act, which he/she would not do in the ordinary course is defined as ragging.
- Ragging is banned in the campus.
- Students should note that ragging is a cognizable criminal offense and those who indulge in it or encourage it will be handed over to law enforcement agencies as per the orders of Supreme Court of India.

USE OF TOBACCO, ALCOHOL ETC.:

Use of Tobacco, Alcohol or any other intoxicants is banned in the premises.

USAGE OF MOBILES

- The use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the college. Once confiscated, it will be returned to the parents/guardian at the end of the academic year. A fine of Rs. 1000/- will be levied on the spot.
- If situations require possession of mobile phones students are advised to deposit the same in the college office and collect it on leaving the campus for the day.
- Students should not play audio/visual devices on the college campus. If found, the devices will be confiscated.

BRINGING VEHICLES TO THE COLLEGE: A LINE OF CAUTION

- Those students who come to the college on two-wheelers should have RC, valid Driving License and Insurance coverage.
- To avoid noise pollution and disturbance, the vehicles should be fitted with good silencers.
- Bringing noisy silencer fitted bikes to the campus strictly 'prohibited.
- Students should park their vehicles only in the place allotted to them.
- Bringing four wheelers to the college by the students is prohibited.

ANTI – RAGGING CELL

- There is a committee consisting of senior faculty members, hostel authorities, etc., to keep vigil over ragging and to prevent it.
- If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student might be given the liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution.




